

Rights of people

Law determines what is the right and what is the duty of every member in a society. Against the right of one person is the duty of another. Every person has his wills. Law controls the will of every person in the correct way. Law protects the interests of every person in a society.

If a person has much money, law protects his money. It is his right to keep this money for himself. If he has a piece of land, it is his right to keep it for himself, to sell it or to give it to another person. Law will not allow another person to take this land by force. People should respect the rights of each other.

Article 88 of the Iraqi Civil Law says that right is an advantage. Law gives this advantage and protects it. Law protects the general interest of people. It also protects the weak people from the strong people.

Islamic Sharee9a determines what a person can own and what he should not own. It says that rights are not absolute. The interest of a society determines the right of every member in it. A person has no right, for example, to sell wine.

The state of Iraq does not allow a person to sell explosives. He has no right to get money from another government.

If a person dies, his family will have the right to inherit him. If a baby is born, it will have the right for good health.

So, law organizes the rights and the duties of every person. Law imposes justice.
