

## Types of right

Rights are different types. There are political rights. A citizen has the right to vote. He can choose one of those who like to be members of the parliament. A citizen has the right to get a high position in the government. These political rights are for Iraqi citizens only. A nonIraqi person cannot vote. These rights stand against some duties. A citizen has the right to vote. Sometimes, it is his duty to vote.

These rights differ from one country to another. In Iraq, every man and woman have the right to vote. In some countries, men only have the right to vote. Women cannot vote.

There are also nonpolitical rights. A citizen has the right to have a name. He has the right to get married. If you have a house, you have the right to live in it, to rent it or to sell it.

Every person has his legal personality. One of the features of this personality is that he should have a name. He can also have his family name. He adds the name of his father to his name.

In Europe, a lady takes the family name of her husband. In Iraq, this is not allowed.
